This Year's Highlights

13 of our 14 athletes medaled in the National Summer Games. 5 gold medals, 2 silver and 12 bronze were earned by SOBC – North Shore athletes.



Athlete Sangeon Yoo and coaches Zak Klein, Jimmy Peterson and Jayne Baggott will be representing our country at the 2015 Summer World Games in Los Angeles, California this summer. Their team was the first BC basketball team to ever earn gold at Nationals and is the first ever Special Olympic basketball team to compete at the world level.



Our 2nd Annual BP Fundraiser raised over \$10,000 as did our 13th Annual Walkathon.



28 athletes and 6 coaches attended the 2015 Winter Provincial Games representing the sports of Alpine Skiing, Cross Country Skiing, Floor Hockey and Snowshoeing.

Alpine skier Jesse Price and snowshoer Alex Evanshen will be attending the Winter National Games as will Alpine Ski Coaches Randy Scott and Molly Evanshen.

SOBC – North Shore hosted its 5th Annual March Madness basketball tournament. It was our best March Madness thus far with 25 teams competing. BC Lion Adam Bighill spoke at Opening Ceremonies and The Honourable Naomi Yamamoto handed out awards. Our shirts sold out, the “big heads” were well received, and a great time was had by all!



6 volunteers and 18 athletes were invited by SOBC to attend the first performance of U2's Innocence & Experience tour. As the result of making a birthday card for Bono and writing his address on it, one of the guests received a parcel containing Larry Mullen Jr.'s drum sticks and U2 guitar picks from Adam Clayton (bass) and The Edge (guitar).
