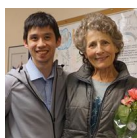
The year in review...

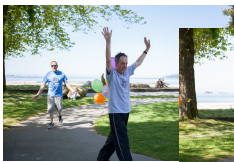
SOBC - North Shore was the recipient of the \$11,300 raised this year at the Annual West Van Run in March. A second West Van Run was held just days ago too.
